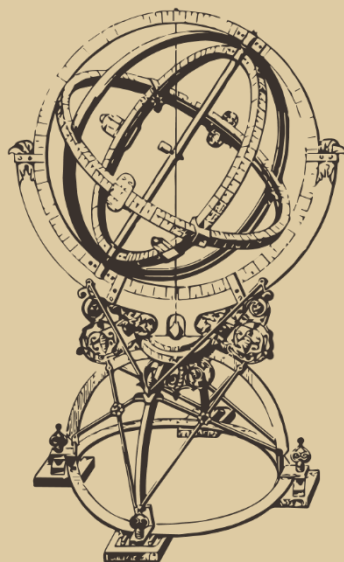


EL COLECCIONISTA
